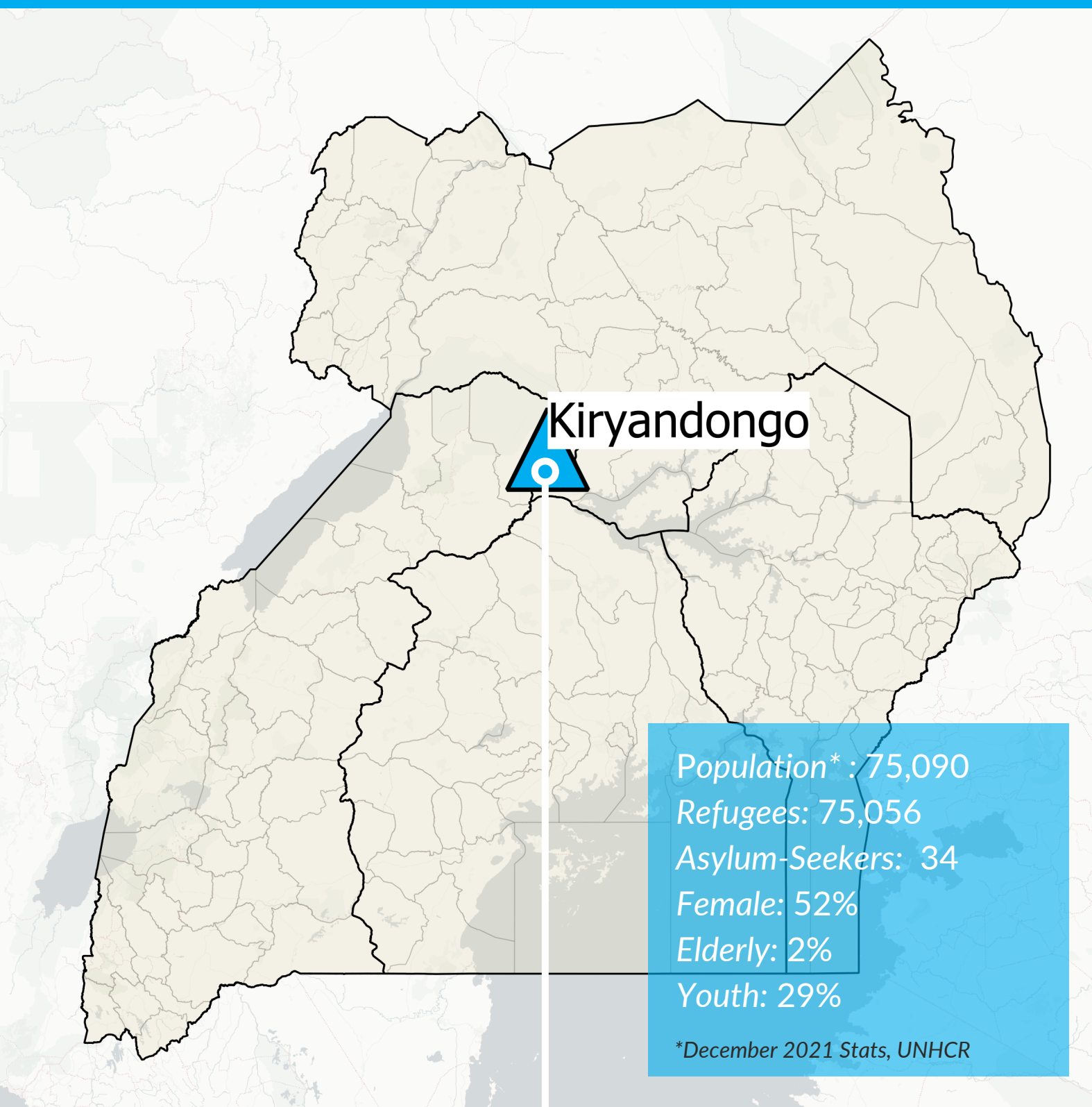


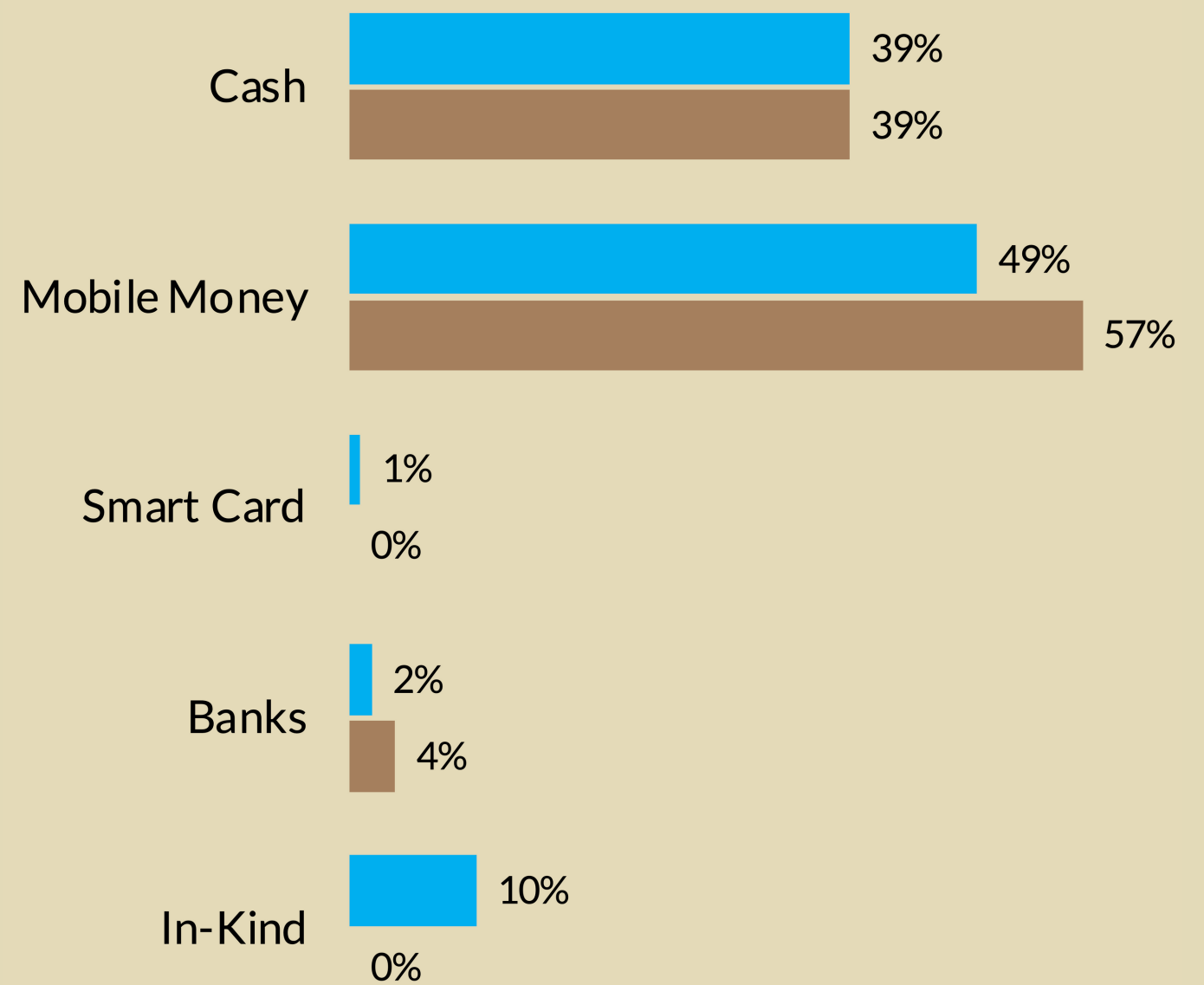
# KIRYANDONGO

## REFUGEE SETTLEMENT

Kiryandongo settlement is located in north western Uganda. In December 2021, the total settlement population was 75,090 with refugees primarily from South Sudan (74K).

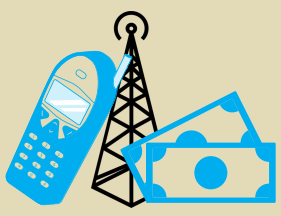

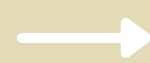

### MINIMUM EXPENDITURE BASKET (MEB)

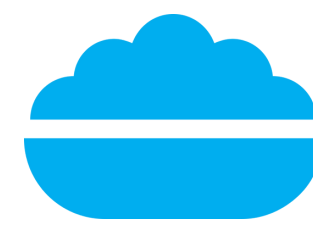

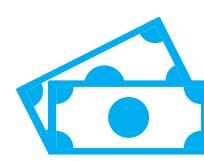
