







Settlement Level Actor Mapping (SLAM)

SLAM is a digital visualisation tool that makes information about settlement-based local actors readily accessible and available in order to increase collaboration, partnerships and networking among actors. SLAM covers the 13 refugee settlements, and Kampala as an urban centre where refugees live.

SLAM supports the visualisation of data on actors present in the OPM's URRMS as a way to enhance the visibility of local actors operating in the Uganda refugee response. Additionally, it provides a centralized visualization where government entities, donors, INGOs, and other stakeholders can easily access accurate, up-to-date, and reliable information on actors.

Uganda Refugee Response Monitoring System (URRMS)

The Uganda Refugee Response Monitoring System (URRMS) is a tool developed by the Office of the Prime Minister (OPM) on behalf of the Government of Uganda to enhance the government's capacity to coordinate, monitor, and report on all aspects of refugee programs, aligning with various sectors.
